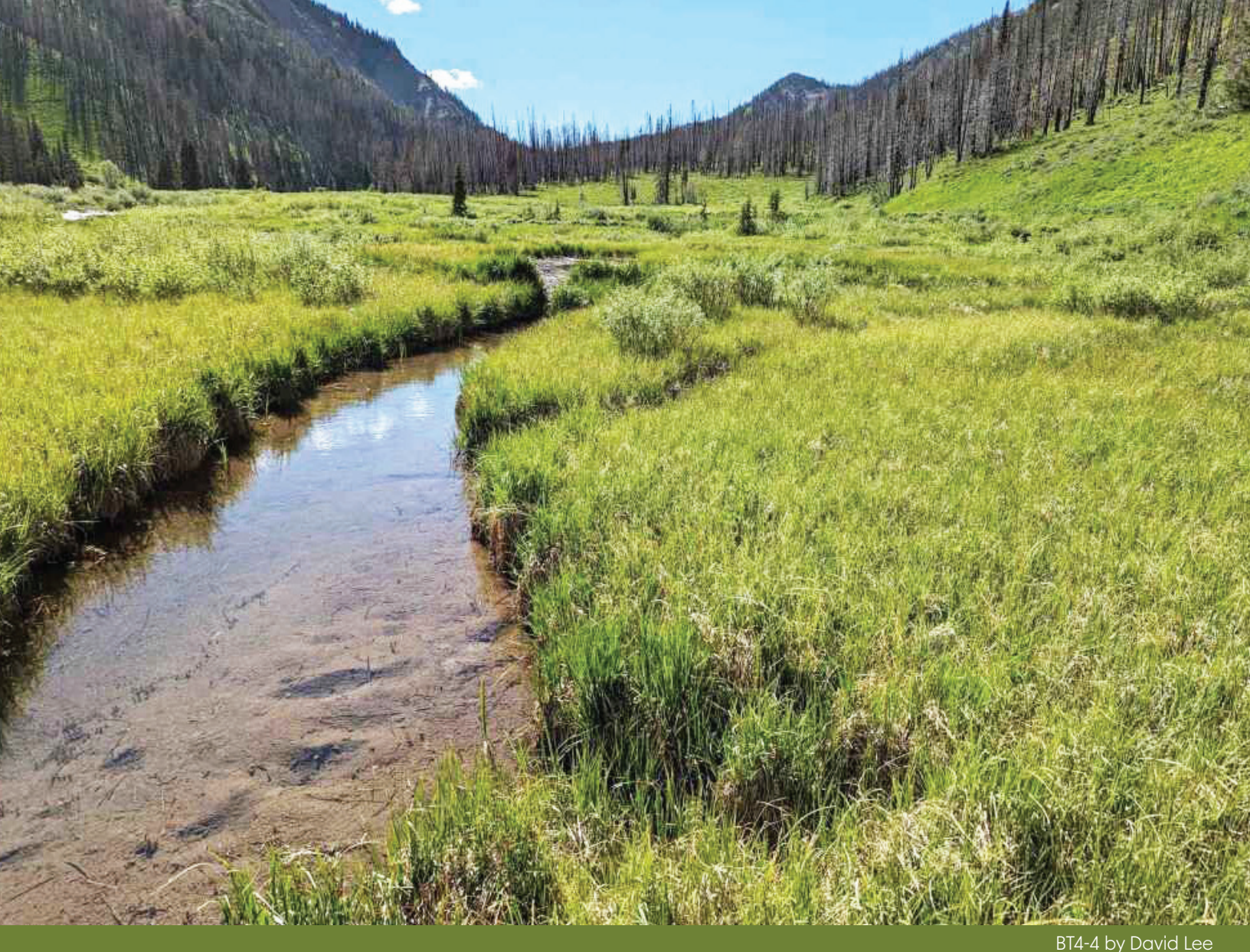


# ROCKY MOUNTAIN AMPHIBIAN PROJECT

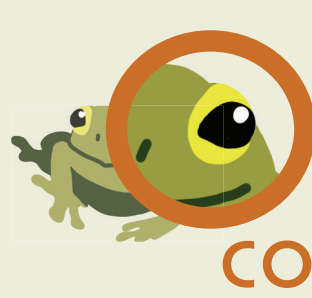

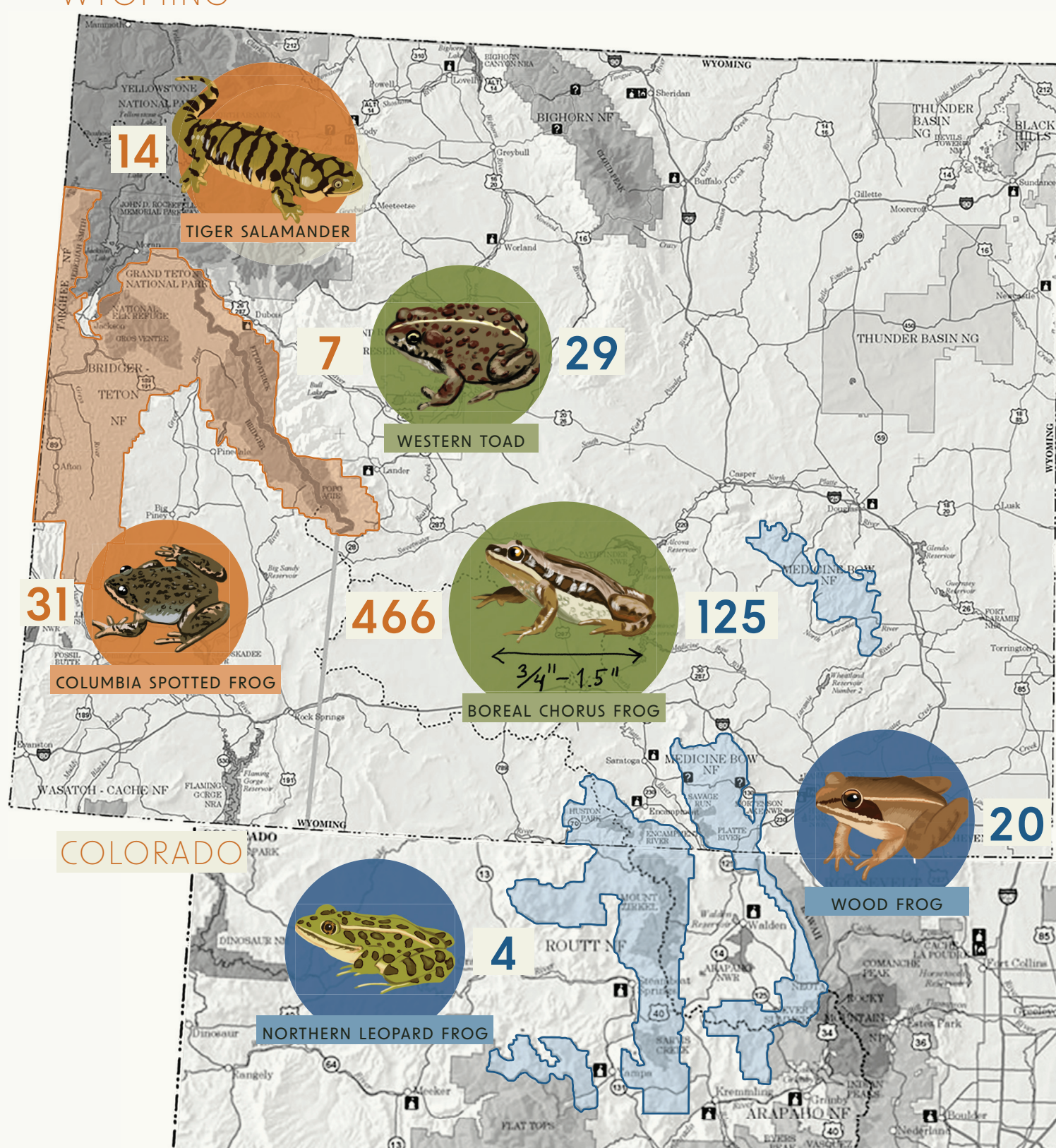
